

Gdańsk incentive

Once the Hanseatic League, **Gdańsk** The capital of Poland's "Pomorze" province is located at the mouth of the Vistula River on the Baltic Sea.

Gdansk is part of the *Trojmiasto*, or *Three-City*, urban area, made up of the towns of Gdansk, Gdynia, and Sopot. The city center, known as Old Town, lies on the Motława, a river that runs into the Vistula 2 miles (3 km) inland. Noteworthy buildings in Old Town include St. Catherine's Church, sections of which date back to the 14th century. Its interior is in the Gothic style. The town hall was built between 1587 and 1595. The entrance hall has a bronze bas-relief of the 17th-century Gdansk astronomer Hevelius. Greatly damaged during World War II, the city's buildings were later restored.



PROGRAMME PROPOSAL:

- **welcome dinner** in the hotel (depending on the location – e.g. dinner **on the roof of the hotel** with a sea view)

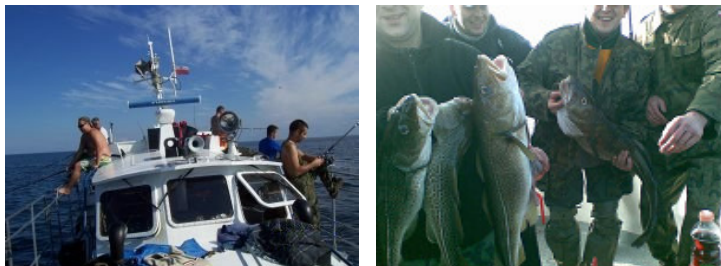

Theme dinner - Sailor's Night

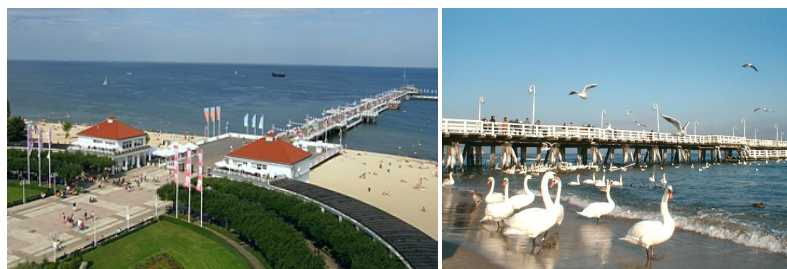
an unforgettable party with shanties live, pipe smoking classes, and dancing on tables in captain hats. All this ends up with a karaoke disco.
